● Program Overview

Summer Language and Culture Program

Chinese Language Lectures We have designed a short and intensive Elementary Chinese Language Program consisting of Chinese comprehension, listening, speaking. You can learn the basics of the standard Chinese language from our professional teaching staff who will guide you into performing your best based on your ability and interest.

Introduction to Chinese Culture The Chinese culture course consists of lectures and exciting activities such as Chinese Martial Arts, Calligraphy, Painting and Music, seminars with Chinese students, tours in Nanjing and visits to places of historical and cultural importance in Jiangsu province, such as Yangzhou, Zhenjiang, and Suzhou. These activities will help students to develop a better understanding on Chinese culture through watching, listening and directly experiencing China's historical and cultural evolution.

Summer International Student Innovation Program

Each year, NUAA students propose several hundreds innovation projects. This year, about 20% of the innovation program will open to international students. In the SISIP, overseas students will join into the innovation program to form international teams with Chinese students. The team will carry out innovation researches under teachers supervising in different science and technology fields in the summer vacation for 8 weeks. Meanwhile, students can study 1 or 2 fundamental or technical courses delivered in English and can obtain credits both for research projects and courses attended.

Several tens projects in fields of Aerospace, Civil Aviation, Mechanical Engineering, Electric and Electronic Engineering, Energy and Power Engineering, Computer Science and Technology, Materials Science and Engineering, Civil Engineering, Physics, Mechanics, Management Science and Engineering, Economics, News and Media are available for international students and more information can be found at website:

Nanjing, or, "the Southern Capital", also the current capital of Jiangsu Province, is situated in the golden Yangtze River Delta. Nanjing is one of the best-known ancient capital cities in China that features a long history and deep cultures. Despite its ancient cultural significance, it is also a vibrantly modern city. The city also plays an important role in the economy, transportation and education of the east part of China, and is the second largest commercial port in the East China following Shanghai. With its majestic landscapes and epic history and cultures, it has become a hotspot for tourists from many parts of the world. In fact, the city will host the 2014 Summer Youth Olympics.

- Population of over 6.13 million and density of 929 per square kilometers
- With respect to the number of universities, Nanjing ranks third in China, just after Beijing and Shanghai.

4) Location



- From Nanjing Lukou International Airport. Take No.1 Airport Shuttle Bus and stop at Xi-huamen (in Chinese) Station, then reach NUA Ming Gugong campus by taxi; or take a taxi to NUA (Minggugong campus) with about RMB110.

- From Nanjing South Railway Station. Take line 1 Metro to Xinjiekou station then transfer to Line 2 Metro and take off at Minggugong Station beside NUA; or take a taxi to NUA (Minggugong campus) with about RMB 30.

- From Nanjing Railway Station. Take No.17 Bus that is 60 meters away from the station exit and stop at Yu Daojie station near NUA West gate; or take line 1 Metro to Xinjiekou station then transfer to Line 2 Metro and take off at Minggugong Station beside NUA; or take a taxi to NUA (Minggugong campus) with about RMB20.
